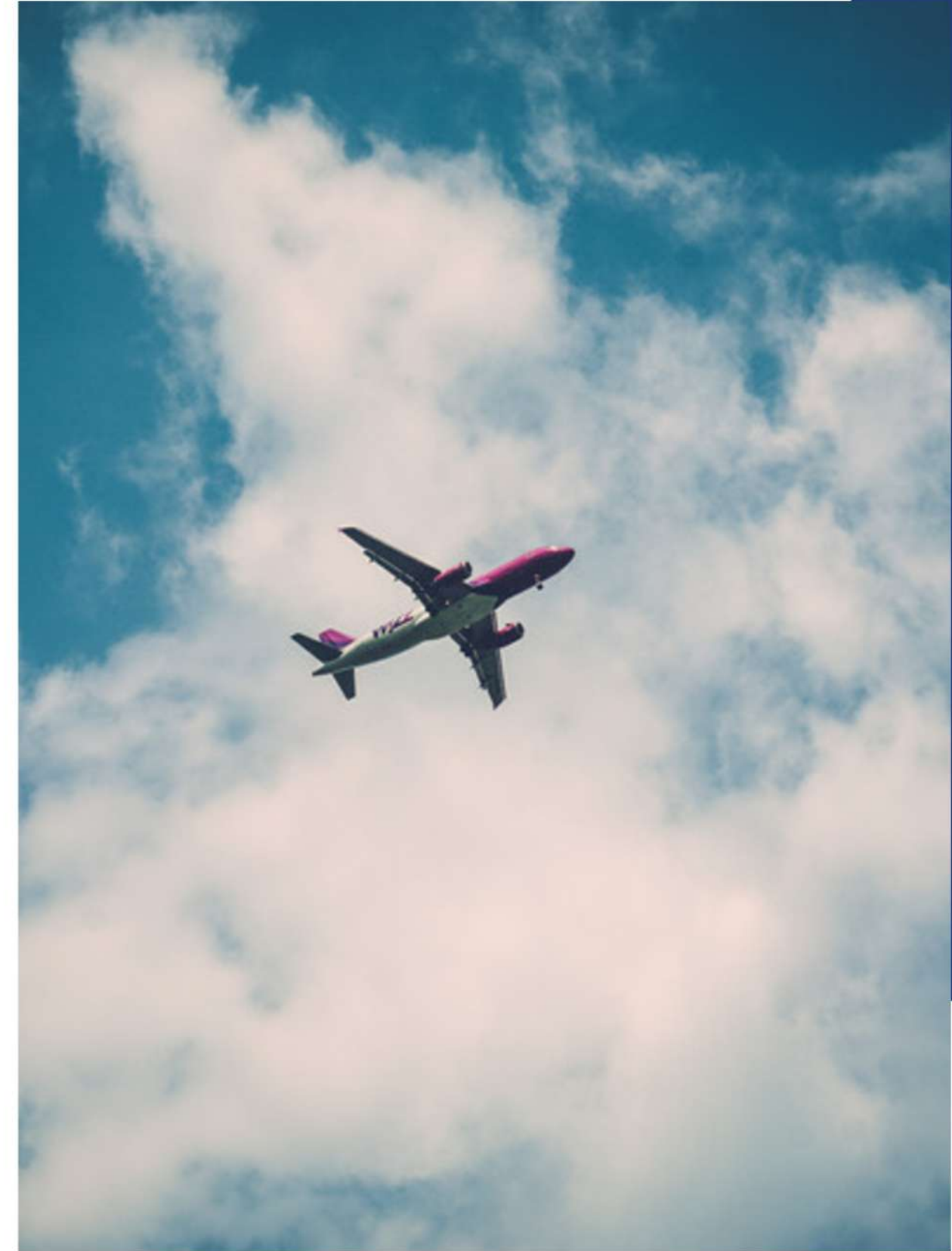

Indian Aviation and Projection

Currently, India has 130 operational airports including 29 international, 91 domestic, and 10 custom airports. To meet the growing demand for air travel in India, it has become imperative to increase the capacity of airport infrastructure.

- Indian carrier's are projected to increase their fleet size to 1,100 Aircraft by 2027.
- Freight Traffic on Indian Airport is expected to cross 11.4 MT by 2032
- Government agencies projects requirement of around 250 brownfield and greenfield passengers by 2037
- India is fastest growing Aviation Market and is expected to cater to 250MN passengers by 2037

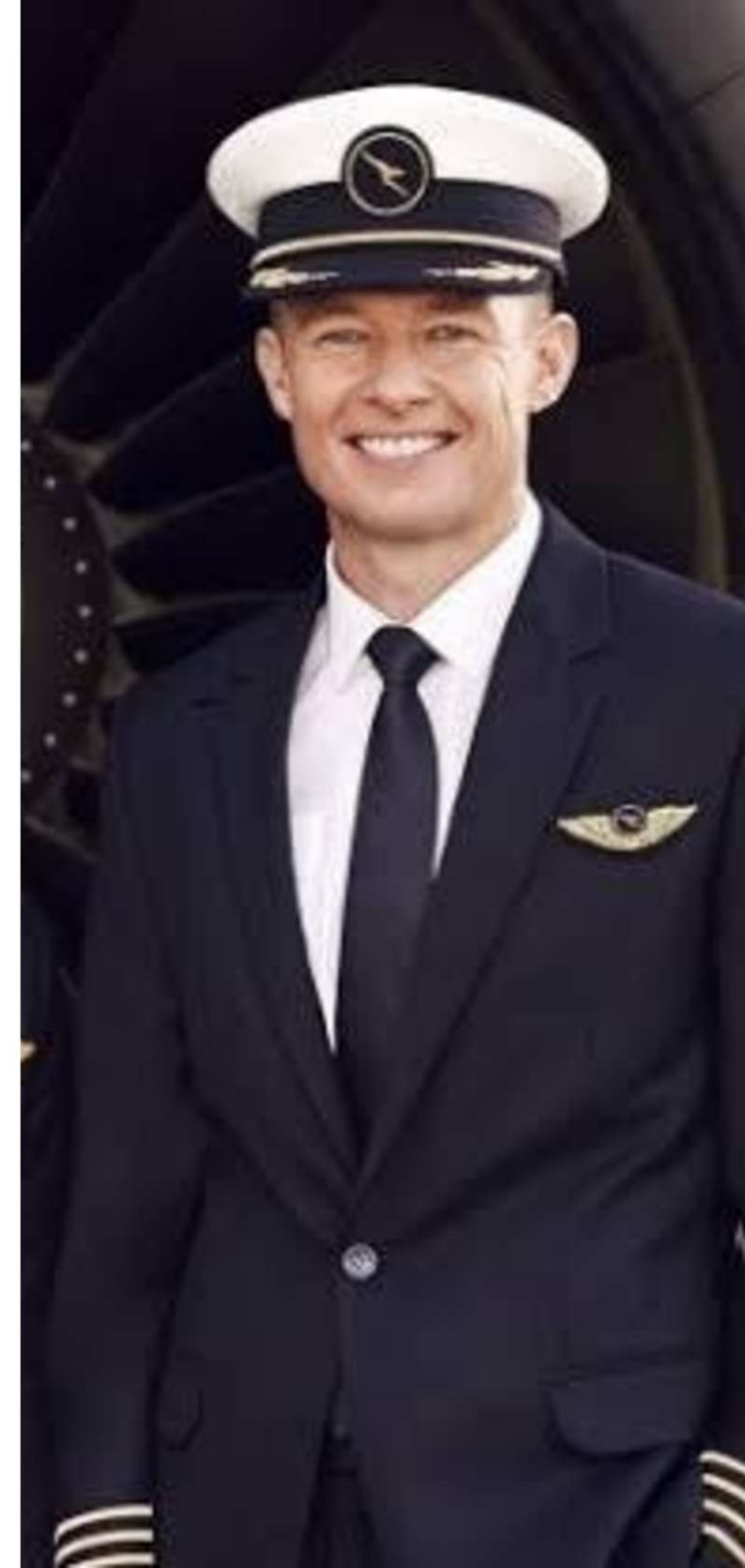
Why and How to become a Pilot

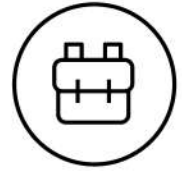
Career and Scope

With choosing aviation as a field of work, one gets a lot of added benefits. You can start early, and sometimes, even as young as 20-year-old. Pilot License can make you eligible to co-pilot an airline planes. That besides, there are provisions of gratuity, and health and housing benefits. A pilot and co-pilot's job is to commandeer vehicles carrying goods, people etcetera for military or commercial purposes. So, you can of course pilot or co-pilot these planes in Commercial Airlines or even Private Jets

Flying clubs are also on the lookout for instructors all the time and a job at a flying club is very respected. Airlines recruit pilots of all nationalities so you can land a job at a national airline and as well as an international airline. With a CPL or an Airline Transport Pilot's License, you are most definitely eligible for a job at the military or paramilitary services. On top of that, celebrities and socialites need pilots for commandeering their jets all the time so you are directly eligible for that job. Needless to say, jobs in the aviation sector, most importantly, as pilots, are very lucrative. Be it in any role, the starting offer of a co-pilot or pilot is Rs 2.5 Lakhs and above. The numbers only escalate with time and experience

6. RADIO TELEPHONY RESTRICTED (AIRPLANE)

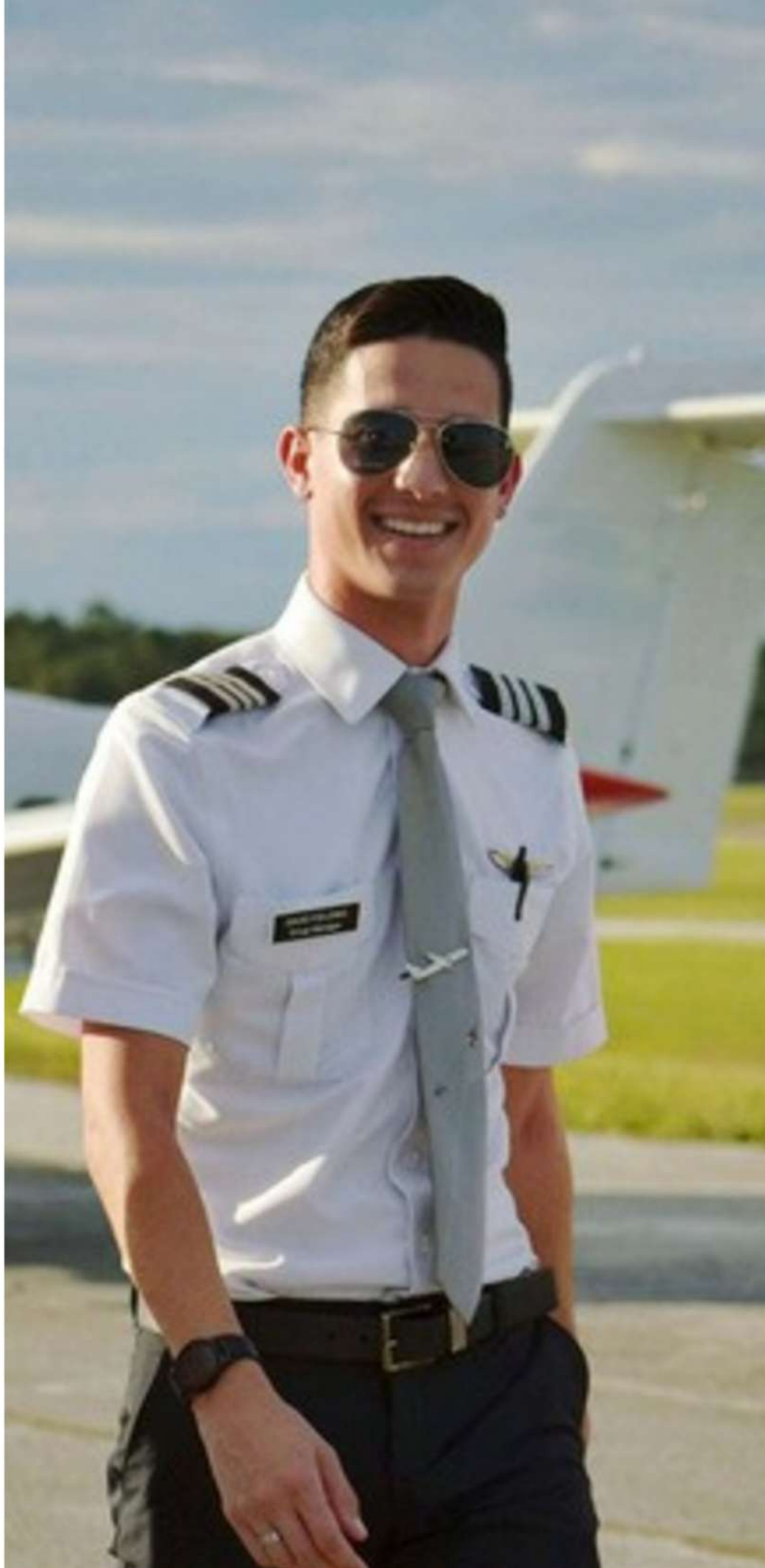
MEDICAL FITNESS CERTIFICATE

A Commercial Pilot has to be Physically and Mentally extremely fit and She/He must undergo the medical fitness with the Indian AirForce Medical Center

CLASS II MEDICAL TEST BY DGCA CERTIFICATION DOCTORS

CLASS I MEDICAL TEST BY AIR FORCE CENTRAL MEDICAL ESTABLISHMENT (AFCME) OR INSTITUTE OF AVIATION MEDICINE (AIM)

Medical certificate requirements include checks of eyesight, ears, psychical examination, electrocardiogram (ECG), lung function, cholesterol blood, hemoglobin blood, chest X-ray, urine, period of validity.

- Minimum age 17 years old. There is no max age to become a Pilot**

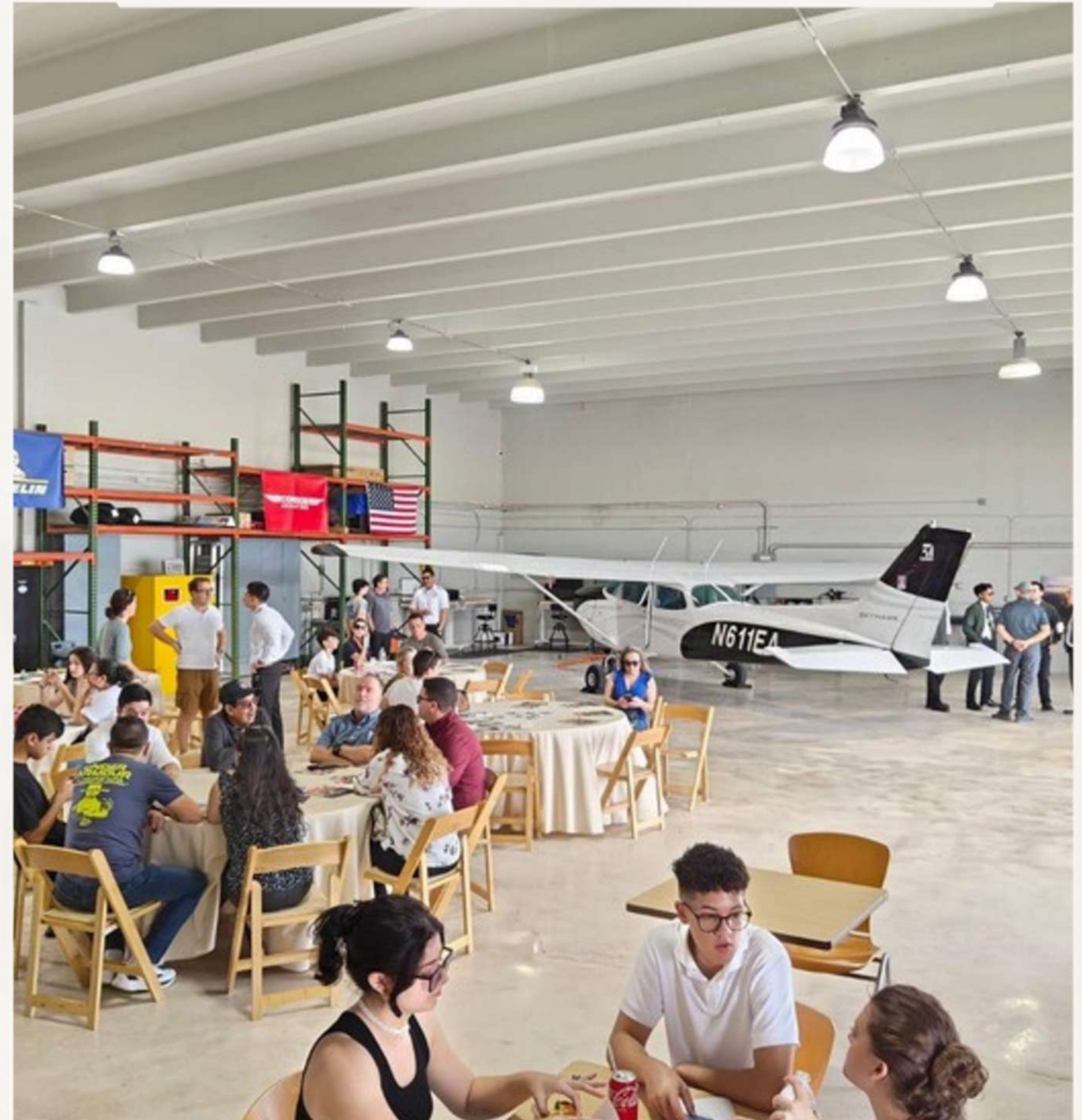
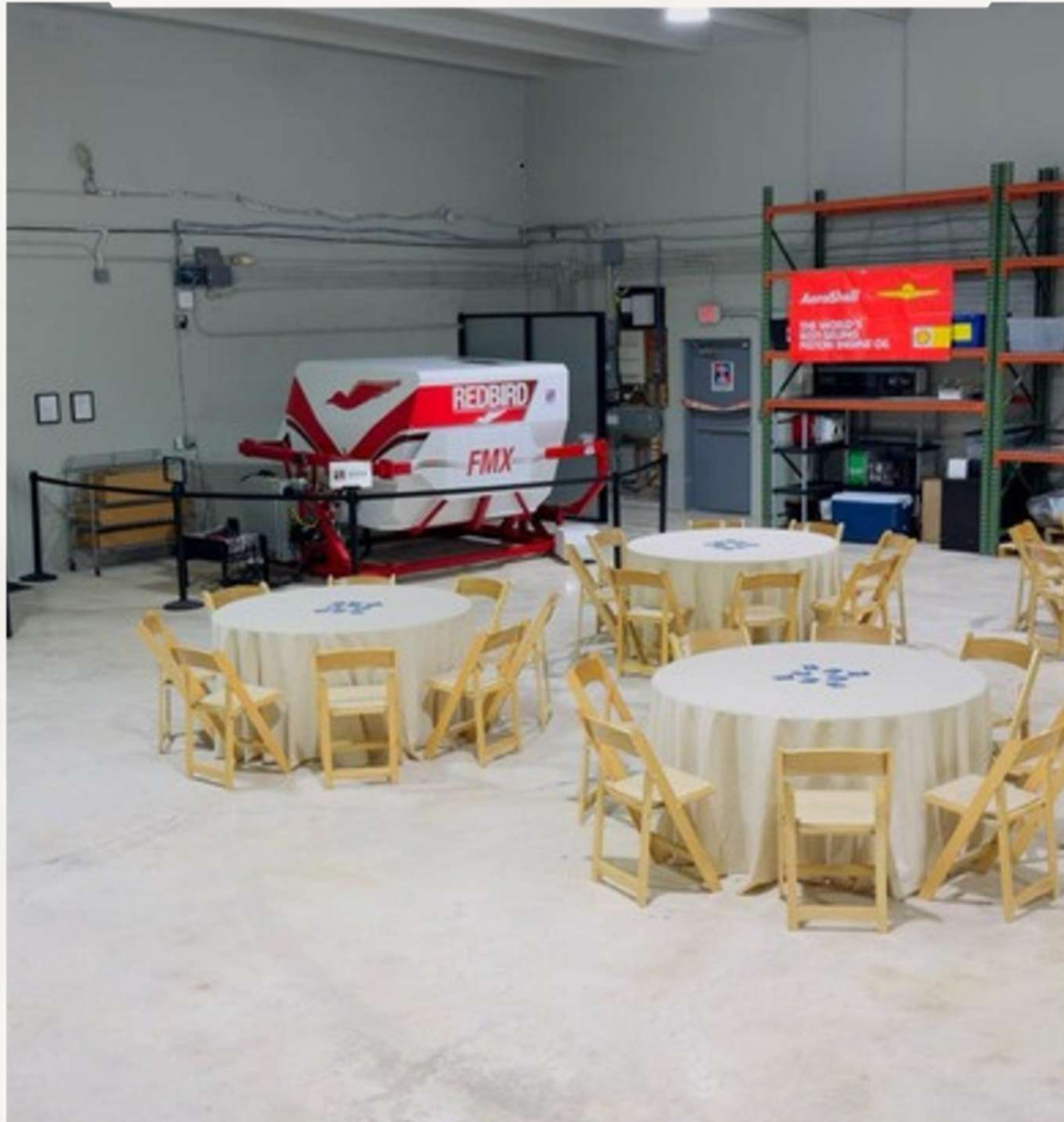
- 10 + 2 Maths and Physics**
